*"The Ninevites believed God. They declared a fast, and all of them, from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth." (v 5)*

#### 3. *Never Too Late*

*"Who knows? God may yet relent and with compassion turn from his fierce anger so that we will not perish." (v 9)*
