### SERMON NOTES – “Genesis: The Fall from Perfection” Genesis 2:18-25 (NIV)

The Fall begins with...

#### 1. A Mockery

*"Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, 'Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden?'" (v 1)*

#### 2. A Mirage (a lie)

*"'You will not surely die,' the serpent said to the woman. 'For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.'" (vv 4-5)*

#### 3. A Mortality

*"Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden. But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"' (vv 8-9)*
