**SERMON NOTES – “Truth Telling: You Will Be with Me”**  
Luke 23:32-43 (NIV)

The 3 Crosses reveal...

1. Choices We Have

*"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it." (Matthew 7:13-14)*

2. An Easy Mistake

*"Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!" (v 39)*

3. A Hard Decision

*"Don't you fear God, since you are under the same sentence? We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong." (vv 40-41)*
